DAY 1, Wednesday, September 4 – Fly to Germany

Transfer from Grand Rapids or Chicago O'Hare Airport for our flight to Germany's impressive capital, Berlin! Our flight will include all meals, beverages, and entertainment. If the Chicago option is decided, we will provide roundtrip private shuttle transportation from West Michigan to the Chicago O'Hare Airport.

DAY 2, Thursday, September 5 – Explore Berlin

Arrive in Berlin this morning. After clearing customs, collecting luggage, and exchanging currency, we will proceed to our private bus that will take us to our centrally located hotel.
